Members of the media is advised that the above mentioned matter will be heard at, Court 6E, the Gauteng Division of the High Court, Pretoria on 1 November 2016.

The media is duly advised that media accreditation **will not** be conducted, however please be advised that once the court room is filled to capacity no further entry will be granted in the interest of public safety.

POOL FEED ARRANGEMENTS

- The SABC will provide the pool video signal feed for all members of the media.
- Microphones and any other equipment placed specifically inside the courtroom should as far as possible not be branded.
- All media are kindly requested to contact **Thomas Sithole**, SABC TV Outside Broadcasts, +27 (0) 83 413 2337 for all matters related to the video feed.

As with the video feed, there will be a pool system for **photographers**, two photographers will be accredited to be inside the courtroom – one local and one international. The photographers are welcome to rotate, however they will not be allowed to rotate during proceedings. The OCJ has requested South African National Editors Forum (SANEF) and the Foreign Correspondents

Association (FCA) to co-ordinate and submit names of photographers who will form a pool for and provide pictures to the media.

Guidelines applicable during the hearing:

1. All media personnel and members of the public are to be seated by 09h45
2. Movement is to be kept to an utmost minimum once proceedings have begun.
3. During proceedings no flash photography will be permitted.
4. The inability to adhere to these guidelines will lead to individuals being requested to leave the courtroom.
