A pre-employment security screening will be conducted on RSA citizenship, criminal record, and credit record and qualification verification. The outcome of this screening will be considered to determine suitability for employment

Who should apply?

Unemployed South African matriculates and graduates, with a tertiary qualification in one of the above mentioned fields of study, who has not been previously employed under any internship programme

Note: Candidates that wish to apply for internship outside their respective Region must be willing and able to find their own accommodation considering that they will not earn a salary but only a stipend. Persons with disabilities are also encouraged to apply. Shortlisted candidates will be required to attend an interview to determine their suitability.
