DETERMINATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 57(5) OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ACT, NO 51 of 1977

REGULATION	DESCRIPTION OF THE OFFENCE	ADMISSION OF GUILT FINE
16 (1) and (2) read with 31(2)	Failure to remain confined to his/her place of residence, unless strictly for the purpose of: (a) Performing an essential service or permitted service, (b) Going to work where a permit has been issued, (c) Buying permitted goods, (d) Obtaining that are allowed to operate in Table 1 to the Regulations; (e) Conveying/moving as allowed children; (f) Walking, running or cycling between the hours of 6h00 to 09h00, within a five kilometre radius of their place of residence:	R3000.00 (Three Thousand Rand)
16 (3) read with 31 (2)	Failure to confine to his/her residence from 20H00 until 05H00 daily except where a person has been granted a permit to perform an essential or permitted service as listed in Annexure D, or is attending to a security or medical emergency.	R3000.00 (Three Thousand Rand)
16 (4)	Moving between provinces metropolitan areas and district except for; (a) For workers who have a permit to perform an essential or permitted service who have to commute to and from work on a daily basis; (b) Attendance of a funeral, as allowed;	R4000.00 (four Thousand Rand)

(c) The transportation of mortal remains and for learners who have to commute to and from school or higher education institution on a daily basis during periods when those institutions are	
permitted to operate
