Moving between provinces, metropolitan areas and/or districts, except for:	R 4000-00
<ul> <li>(a) workers who have a permit to perform an essential or permitted service who have to commute to and from work on a daily basis;</li> <li>(b) the attendance of a funeral, as allowed;</li> <li>(e) the transportation of mortal remains; and</li> <li>(d) for learners who have to commute to and from school or higher education institutions on a daily basis during periods when those institutions are permitted to operate.</li> </ul>	(Repeated offences within the period of the declared national state of disaster must be referred to Court)
