- 1.** The following matters will be called on **Monday 23 June 2025 at 10h00:**

- 4.** Matters will be heard in open court.
- 5.** Introductions will be made in Chambers at 9h45. Attend office 4.13 for introductions.
- 6.** The Family Court Directives must be complied with.
- 7.** No documents may be uploaded on CaseLines after 16h00 on Thursday 19 June 2025, save for practice notes and/or heads of argument for any urgent applications which may still be uploaded on Friday 20 June 2025 before **13h00**.
- 8.** Counsel must have a hard copy of the proposed draft order, with another uploaded to CaseLines.

9. Draft orders must comply with the Directive, including identifying the Presiding Judge, the date of the hearing, and the court room. The draft order should also include the following:

*“This order is made an order of court by the Judge whose name is reflected herein, duly stamped by the registrar of the court, and is submitted electronically to the parties/their legal representatives by e-mail. This order is further uploaded to the electronic file of this matter on CaseLines by the Judge or the Judge's secretary. The date of this order is deemed to be the date of hearing of the matter.”*

10. Allow at least a few days for signed court orders to be uploaded on to the CaseLines platform. Orders which are to be signed urgently must be mentioned in Court.
