DIRECTIVE:

2. Practitioners are required to make introductions at Judge's chamber between 09:15 and 09:45 .
3. Practitioners are required to hand up two draft orders in court, and to ensure that the same draft order is to be uploaded on CaseLines at least 24 hours before the date of hearing. A copy of the draft order in Word format should be prepared and emailed to the Judge's Secretary.

4. Parties are required to submit concise heads of arguments.
5. Removals and postponements will be called first.
6. Matters may, thereafter, be called according to seniority.
7. Any removals, settlements, and postponements should kindly be communicated to the Judge's Secretary as soon as possible on the following email: SMareka@judiciary.org.za
8. Parties must ensure that all witnesses (inclusive of expert witnesses) are on standby to testify should it be required on the date of hearing.
9. Parties must submit a concise practice note (no later than 31st March 2026)
10. Practitioners must inform Ms Mareka (SMareka@judiciary.org.za) before 12h00 the day before the hearing date if any matter will not proceed to avoid papers being read when it is unnecessary to do so.
11. Matters will be called in order of seniority.
12. Counsel/Practitioners should ensure compliance with the relevant Directives.
