Having perused the papers and having heard Counsel for the Applicant, the following Order is made:

1. The respondent is declared to be delinquent by reason of its default in failing to engage in mediation within the terms of the Mediation Directive and Protocol of 22 April 2025 (and its revision) in that it failed to respond to the Applicant's Amplified Rule 41A Notice).
2. The Respondent is ordered to comply with its obligation to respond to the Applicant's Amplified Rule 41A Notice and deliver its Responding Amplified Rule 41A Notice within 10 days of service of this Order.

3. In the event that the Respondent fails to comply as ordered in paragraph 2 above, the Applicant shall be excused from engaging in mediation and be forthwith entitled to set down the case on the appropriate default judgment roll to seek:
  - 3.1. An order holding the Respondent in contempt of this order, and/or
  - 3.2. An order striking out the defence of the respondent; and/or
  - 3.3. An order granting relief in terms of the particulars of claim by default on the prioritised Default Judgment roll; and/or
  - 3.4. An order of costs on the attorney and client scale.
4. The Respondent is ordered to pay the costs of this application on the High Court party and party scale (with scale B for counsel).
