NOTICE IN TERMS OF RULE 16A

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the applicants raise constitutional issues in this matter.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a summary of the constitutional issues raised are the following:

- 1. The applicants contend that the second respondent, who was appointed in terms of section 139(1)(c) of the Constitution, by the fourth respondent, exceeded his powers, by adopting a 2020 valuation roll, budgets and rates and tariffs based thereon, by adopting or revising policies and bylaws, and charging municipal rates and taxes based thereon. The applicants contend that the second respondent so acted in contravention of the spirit and contents of the Constitution in particular of sections 1, 139, 152 and/or 160 of the Constitution.
 - 2. The relevant resolution of the second respondent is annexed to the founding affidavit as annexure "LEX XVIII (A)".
 - 3. The applicants contend that, if the second respondent was duly appointed, his appointment was only valid for 90 days after which his appointment terminated, by virtue of the provisions of section 159(2) of the Constitution read with section 139 thereof.
 - 4. The applicants contend that the aforesaid valuation roll and the adoption of the budget rates, tariffs, policies and bylaws by the second respondent, are unlawful and invalid and should be set aside by virtue of non-compliance with publication, notice, public inspection, public participation and access to information requirements contained in *inter alia* one or more of:

- 4.1 Sections 32 and 162 of the Constitution;
- 4.2 Sections 13, 23, 48, 49 and 50 of the Local Government: Municipal Property Rates Act 6 of 2004;
- 4.3 Section 21A and 21B of the Municipal Systems Act.
- 5. As such it is contended that the valuation roll and all budgets, rates and tariffs based thereon, and the implementation thereof, are unconstitutional, invalid and should be set aside / reviewed and set aside / interdicted.
- 6. The applicants request relief as set out in the notice of motion.
