Contributions should be in the form of articles (8000–10000), notes (5000–8000) and book reviews (500–1000), including footnotes. All articles should be accompanied by an abstract of approximately 250–350 words.

The Editorial Board reserves the right to edit articles as it sees fit. Also, all articles are circulated for double blind peer review. The discretion to publish or not to publish vests in the Editorial Board and its decision in this regard is final. When the Editorial Board decides not to publish a contribution, it will provide feedback to the author in brief broad terms. *SAJEJ* receives contributions on the understanding that authors accept these terms or conditions.

MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Editorial Board welcomes original manuscript submissions written in English. The format of the article should be 1.5 spacing, font Arial 11, justify and in MS Word.
