ZUMA MATTER, 8 DECEMBER 2020, PIETERMARITZBURG HIGH COURT

Members of the media are advised that the matter involving the Thales Group and former

President Jacob Zuma will return to the Pietermaritzburg High Court on 8 December 2020.

procedures as will be communicated by court officials.
