JUDICIAL CONDUCT TRIBUNAL TO CONDUCT HEARINGS ON THE COMPLAINT LODGED BY JUSTICES OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT AGAINST JUDGE PRESIDENT HLOPHE

The media is advised that the Judicial Conduct Tribunal (Tribunal) comprising of Judge Joop Labuschagne, a retired Judge of the Gauteng Division of the High Court, designated in terms of section 22(1)(a) of the Judicial Service Commission Act, 1994 as the Tribunal President, and Judge Tati Makgoka, a Judge of the Supreme Court of Appeal, as well as Ms Nishani Pather, a practising attorney, will commence with hearings of the complaint lodged by the Justices of the Constitutional Court against Judge President Hlophe.

The hearings will take place as follows:
