CIVIL MATTER: AMAZULU ROYAL FAMILY, 11-12 JANUARY 2022, PIETERMARITZBURG HIGH COURT

Members of the media are advised that the civil case matter involving the AmaZulu Royal Family will be heard at the KwaZulu Natal Division of the High Court, Pietermaritzburg from 11-12 January 2022.

In an attempt to prevent the spread of COVID-19, strict social distancing protocols will be observed in the courtroom. Members of the media and the public are requested to follow all security procedures as will be communicated by court officials in order to ensure the safety of all court users.

Access to the courtroom will be for accredited persons only. Please be advised that a **very limited** number of seats are allocated for accredited members of the media inside the courtroom. Members of the media are requested to submit their accreditation requests to Pfunzo Mafenya at PMafenya@judiciary.org.za and CC LNtuli@judiciary.org.za by **16h00 Monday, 10 January 2022**. Requests received after the closing time will not be considered.

Requests for accreditation must include the individual's name, name of the organisation/media house they represent, ID number / Passport number, designation, and contact details. Personal information will be processed in line with the Protection of Personal Information Act (Act No. 4 of 2013).

Accreditation cards will be available and distributed to approved applicants. This will be communicated via email once accreditation has been finalised.
