STATE V ZUMA AND ANOTHER (THALES SOUTH AFRICA), 17 MAY 2022, PIETERMARITZBURG HIGH COURT

The matter State v Jacob Zuma and Another (Case number: CCD30/2018) is set down to be heard in open court at the KwaZulu Natal Division of the High Court, Pietermaritzburg, on 17 May 2022.

Strict social distancing protocols continue to be observed in the courtroom. Members of the media and the public are requested to follow all security procedures as will be communicated by court officials in order to ensure the safety of all court users.

Media access to the venue will be by accreditation only. Members of the media interested in covering the proceedings are requested to apply for accreditation by submitting their details using the template provided here - https://www.judiciary.org.za/index.php/news/media-accreditation - to Ms Zininzi Makgoale at ZMakgoale@judiciary.org.za_and CC LNtuli@judiciary.org.za, and lusanda02@gmail.com, by no later than 15h00 on Thursday, 12 May 2022. Accreditation applications not submitted using the provided template will not be considered. Personal information will be processed in line with the Protection of Personal Information Act (Act No. 4 of 2013).

Accreditation cards will be distributed to approved applicants. This will be communicated via email once accreditation has been finalised.
