OPENING OF NEW VICTIM SUPPORT ROOM AT THE WESTERN CAPE HIGH COURT

The Acting Judge President of the Western Cape Division of the High Court, Judge Patricia

Goliath, will on 31 March 2023 officially open a new Victim Support Room at the Western Cape

Town High Court.

The Victim Support Room will provide a safe space within the court system for victims of

violent crimes. Victims of crime who are required to testify in criminal matters will receive the

necessary support and guidance relating to court processes. Court Preparation Officers and

Intermediaries will be available to accompany witnesses and facilitate a victim-centred

approach to ensure that their well-being remains central in the criminal justice system.

The Victim Support Room will be implemented in collaboration with the National Prosecuting

Authority (NPA), the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development (DoJ&CD) and

other stakeholders. It is envisaged that the Victim Support Room will provide witnesses with

practical information and ongoing support from the start to the end of the court process, and

after sentencing.

With this kind of support, witnesses will be empowered and able to provide testimony as

required, whilst the Court will benefit by receiving the necessary testimony to assist it in

adjudicating matters before it. The Victim Support Room will therefore make a positive

contribution towards enhancing the effectiveness of the criminal justice system.
