STATE V ZUMA AND ANOTHER (THALES SOUTH AFRICA), 17 APRIL 2023, PIETERMARITZBURG HIGH COURT

The matter State v Jacob Zuma and Another (Case number: CCD30/2018) is set down to be heard in open court at the KwaZulu Natal Division of the High Court, Pietermaritzburg, on 17 April 2023.

Media access to the venue will be by accreditation only. Accreditation cards will be distributed to approved applicants. This will be communicated via email once accreditation has been finalised.
