### **STATE V ZUMA AND ANOTHER (THALES SOUTH AFRICA), 20 March 2024, PIETERMARITZBURG HIGH COURT**

The matter State v Jacob Zuma and Another (Case number: CCD30/2018) is set down to be heard in open court in the KwaZulu-Natal Division of the High Court, Pietermaritzburg, on 20 March 2024.

Judgment will be handed down in the second application for the removal of Adv Billy Down from the prosecution trial of Mr Zuma.

Media access to the venue will be by accreditation only.
