- 3. Draft orders must be duly completed and compliant (i.e. must contain the details of counsel, reflect the date of the hearing, and the Judge's particulars). Draft orders must be uploaded onto CaseLines/CourtOnline in PDF and Word format, and counsel must bring a copy to the hearing in court. This order must be signature ready (i.e. remove the word "draft" from the tramlines, delete the "further and/or alternative relief" prayer
- etc.) Orders will be delivered by uploading same onto CaseLines/CourtOnline.
- 4. The attention of all parties is specifically drawn to the provisions of subparagraph 164.1 of the Judge President's Revised Practice Directive 1 of 2021 (8 July 2022) dealing with practice notes. These are to be uploaded at least one full court day prior to the date of the hearing. The purpose of the practice note is to assist the Court in the efficient disposal of the matter. In the premises, a practice note which merely describes what type of matter the Court is dealing with is of no assistance at all. The practice note should set out all the pertinent issues of the matter and precisely where each may be found on

CaseLines/CourtOnline. In this way, the Court will be able to ascertain whether the applicant is entitled to the relief sought or not.

- 5. Parties with CourtOnline matters must follow the "7-Steps" to ensure that their CourtOnline matters bundle onto CaseLines.
- 6. Parties should note that Judge's secretary cannot assist parties in creating the bundle and uploading documents on court online to caselines and should liaise with the court online helpdesk at CourtOnlineSupport@judiciary.org.za; telephone Number: -010 493 2600 or go to office 008.
