MATTERS BEFORE JUSTICE HOLLAND-MUTER J

- Kindly note that the matters detailed in the attached opposed motion roll have been allocated to Holland-Muter J.
- 2. Matters will be dealt with in open Court and the parties will be informed of the courtroom prior to the hearing.
- All documents and the <u>joint practice note</u> in each matter must be uploaded onto CaseLines by Friday 27 October 2023 and must also be emailed <u>kmatha@judiciary.org.za</u> After receipt of all joint practice notes the Court will allocate matters to specific days.
- 4. Counsel should ensure that the joint practice note filed shall address all the requirements detailed in paragraph 154 of the Judge President's Consolidated Directive, 2 of 2022. Should a joint practice note not be filed, the parties must each file a separate practice note and may indicate why a joint practice note could not be filed. The practice note must indicate under which sections the relevant papers are to be found on CaseLines, which must be read.

5. Parties are requested to file a chronology simultaneously with the practice

note.

6. Parties are requested to email proposed draft orders in Word format to

kmatha@judiciary.org.za_at least a day before a particular matter is

enrolled and must be uploaded on CaseLines. Parties are requested to

bring a hard copy of the proposed draft order to Court.

7. Where matters are to be removed, postponed or have become settled, the

parties must email Mr Matha without delay at kmatha@judiciary.org.za

For matters removed there will be no need for appearance

8. Introductions are not necessary, and parties may introduce themselves on

calling of their matters.

9. The Court requests hardcopies of core bundles the parties wish to rely on

by Friday 27 October 2023. In matters where parties cannot agree on a

core bundle, the entire bundle must be provided. The heads of argument

must be provided to the Judge's Registrar at least two days before the

hearing of the matter.
