**URGENT FAMILY COURT ROLL (31 OCTOBER 2023)**

**DIRECTIVES BY HONOURABLE ACTING JUDGE THUPAATLASE**

- 1. Documents must be uploaded in all matters to the CaseLines digital platform**, including in instances where it is a CourtOnline matter. Only matters that have been uploaded on CaseLines shall be heard. **All non-compliant matters shall be removed from the roll.**

- For assistance with bundling a CourtOnline matter to CaseLines, kindly follow the attached 7 Steps or contact the Court Online call centre 010 493 2600.
- 2. Court commences at 10:00am. Counsel are required to remain on standby in the MS Teams hearing.
- 3. The hearing for all applications will be conducted as videoconferences using the Microsoft Teams platform. The link to the videoconferences must be obtained from this roll as it will not be e-mailed separately.
- 4. Attention is drawn to the provisions of chapter 10.5 of the High Court Practice Manual, and in particular paragraph 1 thereof which provides:
  - 4.1. 'It is hereby emphasised that no person may film or electronically record judicial proceedings without the prior permission of the presiding Judge. The granting and the terms of any such permission is within the discretion of the presiding Judge.....'
- 5. **Self-represented litigants** will be accommodated in **Office 1236** on the 12<sup>th</sup> floor at the Johannesburg High Court, in circumstances where they do not have access to their own facilities to join the videoconference via MS Teams; attorneys are required to advise unrepresented litigants of same, where possible.
  - 5.1. Self-represented litigations making use of the Courts facilities are required to be at court by 09h00 on the day of their hearing.
  - 5.2. Please ensure that you inform [MMagadla@judiciary.org.za](mailto:MMagadla@judiciary.org.za), by no later than 08h30 on the day of your hearing, of your attendance at court.
- 6. Should an order be granted, a Microsoft Word version of the draft order must be emailed to the Judge's Secretary ([MMagadla@judiciary.org.za](mailto:MMagadla@judiciary.org.za)) as soon as possible after the matter has been heard.
- 7. Stamped and signed copies of draft orders will be uploaded to CaseLines/CourtOnline within a day of the order being granted.
