- 4. The hearing of all unopposed motions will be conducted in open court. The courtroom allocation will be circulated by the DJP's secretary.**
- 5. Parties should kindly note that all bundles will be frozen by 14:00pm on 16 November 2023. No party is allowed to unfreeze the bundles and in the event that bundles have**
