6. Draft orders must correctly reflect the number on the roll and correct case numbers.
7. The Court will not deal with matters that were not placed timeously, if your matter was properly enrolled but does not appear on this roll, please contact the enrolment office.
8. Parties are to ensure that all documents inclusive of draft orders and practice notes are uploaded at least 3 days before the date of set down.
9. Where matters settle or are to be removed, ensure that a note to the effect is made timeously on caselines, a notice of removal is served and uploaded and/or a draft order encapsulating the removal terms/ settlement terms is uploaded and handed up to Court.
10. Please allow 5 court days for signed orders to be uploaded.
11. Parties are reminded to comply with the Practice Directive relating to the evidence affidavit.
