DIRECTIVE:

The following process and proceedings shall apply to **ALL** trial interlocutory Court applications during the week of 7-11 October 2024:

- 1. All special interlocutory Court applications will be heard in **open Court** for the entire week. Court will commence at 10h00 unless otherwise indicated.
- 2. The customary Practice Note (incorporating counsel's name, e-mail address and cell number) in accordance with the Practice Directives must be uploaded to CaseLines by 16h00 on 4 October 2024. A failure to do this may result in the matter being struck from the roll.
- 3. Documents must be uploaded in all matters to CaseLines. Only matters that have been uploaded on CaseLines shall be heard. Matters initiated on Court Online <u>must be bundled</u> to CaseLines in accordance with the Practice Directives and "7 Step to Bundle". If matters are not bundled to CaseLines by 16h00 on 4 October 2024, the matters may be struck from the roll.
- 4. The customary Draft Order (incorporating counsel's name, e-mail address and

cell number) must be presented among the documents uploaded to CaseLines and **one copy** is to be handed up during the hearing of the application in open Court.

- 5. A respondent who, despite being late to do so, wishes to oppose the granting of an order, must communicate that fact by e-mail to RMunonela@judiciary.org.za and to the applicant and otherwise comply with this Directive.
- 6. Counsel or attorneys for an applicant must at once when it becomes known that there is opposition, regardless of its merits, communicate that fact to RMunonela@judiciary.org.za.
- 7. Any concerns which the Court has in any special interlocutory application may be noted by the Court on the <u>updated</u> printed roll, which may also give an indication of the probable fate of each application.
- 8. Any postponements and removals must timeously be communicated to the Judge's Registrar at RMunonela@judiciary.org.za.
- 9. Introductions may be done in open Court.
