FAMILY COURT DIRECTIVES:

1. ALLOCATIONS AND INTRODUCTIONS

- 1.1. All matters will be heard in open Court unless the presiding Judge directs otherwise.
- 1.2. Parties may check Court room allocations on the JSA Bar website: <u>https://www.johannesburgbar.co.za/court-rolls/</u>
- 1.3. Urgent applications will be heard on Tuesday, *18 February 2025*.
- 1.4. Introductions will be done by Counsel/Attorneys in open Court upon their matters being called on Record.

2. ACCESSIBILITY

2.1. CaseLines Bundles are to be created in accordance with the prevailing Practice Directives of this Division and, without detracting from the generality of the aforegoing, must include clearly demarcated Sections, with documents/annexures being properly identified and uploaded separately, and without there being any duplication. Non-compliance will result in matters being removed from the Roll.

3. **PRACTICE NOTES, HEADS OF ARGUMENT AND DRAFT ORDERS**

- 3.1. Parties are to ensure that in all Opposed matters, Heads of Argument have been filed in accordance with the prevailing Practice Directives of this Division.
- 3.2. Draft Orders must be uploaded onto CaseLines. Counsel must, in addition thereto, physically bring one hard copy to Court on the hearing date.
- 3.3. The Draft Order is to reflect the date, particulars of the presiding Judge, details of the Attorney of record, and of the Counsel/Attorney appearing.

- 3.4. The Orders which are brought to Court, **must** be "signature-ready" (i.e. please remove the word "Draft" from the tramlines, delete the "further and/or alternative relief" prayer etc).
- 3.5. Accordingly marked, signed and stamped Court Orders will duly be delivered using the platforms at the disposal of the respective parties.

4. URGENT APPLICATIONS

- 4.1. There must be strict compliance with the prevailing Practice Directives of this Division as applicable to urgent applications.
- 4.2. The allocation of a hearing date and time to an urgent application does not automatically translate into such application being regarded as urgent.
