Directives:

Incompliance with the Judge President and the Deputy Judge President's directives for the opposed motion court roll, the following directives shall be observed.

- 1. All opposed motions will be heard in open court;
- 2. Introductions will take place in the Judge's Chambers 407 at 9h30. Court proceedings commence at 10h00 or shortly thereafter.
- 3. The roll shall be called as follows-
- a) removals
- b) settlements
- 4. Where applicable, two copies of a draft order shall be available to be handed up in court, when a matter is heard;
- 5. Opposed Summary Judgments: The respondent's opposing affidavit shall be filed and uploaded to the electronic file by no later than 5 court days before the date upon which the case was initially set down on the unopposed roll.
- 6. Practice Notes: In any opposed motion, counsel must hold a pre-hearing conference and prepare a joint practice note setting out and incorporating the issues contained in paragraph 25.17 of the Revised Consolidated Practice Directive 1 of 2024. A comprehensive practice note, stating the nature of the application and the date on which the application is on the roll, should have been filed

- on Caselines 5 court days before the hearing. Counsel must have regard to the Judge President's most recent directive.
- 7. In all applications where heads of argument must be filed, a failure to do so may result in the application being struck of the roll.
- 8. Counsel is requested to have regard to the 'Widely Shared Note' function on Caselines as queries may be raised using this function.
