**DIRECTIVES WITH REGARD TO FAMILY COURT MATTERS**

**01 – 05 DECEMBER 2025**

**IEM DELPORT, AJ**

1. All matters allocated to IEM Delport AJ will be heard in Open Court – Family Court will commence at 10:00.

2. One Draft Order must be handed up. **Please ensure that the name of the judge reflected on the draft order is IEM Delport AJ.**
3. Introductions will be done in open court.
4. In respect of unopposed divorces, **unless otherwise indicated via the widely shared function on CaseLines prior to the hearing of the matter,** the following shall apply:
  - 4.1. All unopposed divorces will be heard on Monday 2 December 2025 from 10:00.
  - 4.2. Divorces where there are settlement agreements and no minor children, may be called and finalised on the documentary evidence and evidence affidavits, provided that all documents are uploaded to Caselines and all relevant information is properly before court by Friday 29 August 2025 at 12:00.
  - 4.3. All unopposed divorces where there is no settlement agreements will be dealt with by way of *viva voce* evidence.
  - 4.4. In unopposed divorces, where minor children are involved, settlement agreements must be endorsed by the Office of the Family Advocate and *viva voce* evidence needs to be led.
5. All urgent applications are to be heard on Tuesday, 2 December 2025 from 12:00 or at a time as agreed upon in open court.

6. All other unopposed family matters and opposed other family matters will be heard on Wednesday, 3 December 2025.
7. Opposed Rule 43 applications will be heard on Thursday, 4 December 2025.
8. Counsel is requested to have regard to the widely shared note function on CaseLines as queries may be raised and/or notes may be distributed using this function prior to the hearing date.

10. If there is non-compliance with the provisions of the Consolidated Practice Directive applicable to the Family Court (this includes failure to timeously file practice notes as required) matters may be struck from the roll.

In all opposed 43 applications and opposed urgent applications, the parties **must upload a Practice Note onto CaseLines on or before Friday 28 November 2025 at 16:00**, indicating the details of the legal representatives and advocates/attorneys appearing on behalf of each party; the common cause facts; the disputes to be adjudicated; the documents to be read; and the estimated time duration.
