1. The urgent court roll will be called in open court at 10h00 on Tuesday, 15 September 2026. All parties and legal practitioners should attend the roll call unless excused or specifically allocated to another date or time.
2. Any specific allocation will be communicated by 12h00 on Monday, 14 September 2026. Once a matter has been allocated, the parties need only attend court on the allocated date and at the allocated time
3. A practice note must be uploaded to CaseLines by 10h00 on Monday, 14 September 2026.
4. In opposed matters, heads of argument must be uploaded to CaseLines by 12h00 on Monday, 14 September 2026, and emailed to the Judge's Registrar in editable Microsoft Word format.
5. Each practice note must identify the main issues for determination, briefly summarise the material facts and legal issues, state the relief sought, identify the papers to be read with accurate CaseLines references, record the estimated duration of the hearing, and provide the contact details of the legal practitioners who will appear.

6. The parties must ensure that a complete and properly indexed set of papers is available on CaseLines, including where the matter was initiated on Court Online. Any matter that is not accessible on CaseLines by 12h00 on Monday, 14 September 2026, runs the risk of being struck off the roll. The requirements of rule 6(12), the Practice Manual and all applicable Practice Directives must be fully complied with.
7. Each proposed order must be uploaded to CaseLines and emailed to the Judge's Registrar in editable Microsoft Word format. Each order must be signature-ready and must:
 - a. be headed **COURT ORDER**, rather than **DRAFT ORDER**, with the word "draft" removed wherever it appears in the tramlines or title;
 - b. display the matter's urgent court roll number in the top left-hand corner;
 - c. reflect the correct case number, the name of the presiding Judge and the date of hearing;
 - d. use the court heading **GAUTENG DIVISION, JOHANNESBURG**;
 - e. state, at the end, the names and contact details of counsel and the instructing attorneys, including their email addresses and telephone numbers; and
 - f. omit any prayer for "further and/or alternative relief".
8. If a matter has been settled, will not proceed or is to be removed, the parties must notify the Judge's Registrar without delay. If the matter has already been allocated, the Registrar of the allocated Judge must also be notified. The appropriate notice of removal or proposed consent order must be uploaded promptly.

9. The Court may communicate with the parties through widely shared notes posted on CaseLines or by email. Legal practitioners must monitor these communications and respond promptly.
10. The allocation of a date or time does not constitute a finding that a matter is urgent.
11. A matter that does not comply with these directives may be removed from the roll.
