Re-Opening of the Provisional Court Rolls- 1<sup>st</sup> Term, week 1 January 2022.

Kindly be advised of the following progressive developments in relation to date allocations;

1. The motion applications section is currently allocating provisional dates in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of March 2022 (unopposed motion court).
2. After relevant successful consultations, the unopposed motion court has been allocated 2 additional Judges by the Judge President and for the 1<sup>st</sup> Court Term in 2022, which expands the number to 4 motion courts seating from Monday to Thursday.
3. The above allocation is enabling the office to re-open the provisional rolls as per the following;
  - 3.1 The unopposed motion court rolls for week 1, commencing 17<sup>th</sup> of January 2022 to the last week of term is opened for provisional and final enrolment.
  - 3.2 The opened court rolls will prioritize Interlocutory, Ex-Parte and Interdict applications.
  - 3.3 Matters with the above relevant classifications already allocated dates in March 2022 are encouraged to re-apply (re-invite the office profile with a Widely Shared Case Note, stating your intention to have an earlier date allocated).
4. Practitioners are advised to process the above with an element of urgency so as to enable the office to continue doing its work as elegantly as possible.
