## DIRECTIVES FOR THE UNOPPOSED MOTION COURT ON 10, 12 & 14 JANUARY 2022 BEFORE DAVIS J

The unopposed motion courts before Judge Davis for **Monday 10 January, Wednesday 12 January and Friday 14 January 2022** will be run as follows:

- In all matters the proposed draft order with the <u>Judges name</u> must be emailed in Word format to Judge Davis' secretary, Ms Mabona(<u>TMabona@judiciary.org.za</u> & <u>Tumetsi.judicairy@gmail.com</u>) and be uploaded on caselines by no later than 15h00 on Friday 7 January 2022 for the roll of 10 January 2022, no later than 15h00 on Tuesday 11 January 2022 for the roll of 12 January 2022 and no later than 15h00 on Thursday 13 January 2022 for the roll of 14 January 2022 (Practice note to be uploaded on caselines)
- 2. Where difficulty is experienced in uploading to Caselines, Ms Mabona may be contacted to assist.

- 3. All matters which are in order will be disposed of on paper unless practitioners wish to make oral submissions. If this is the case, that must be clearly stated in the practice note or in a supplementary practice note which must be delivered together with the proposed draft order. Practitioners must in any event be available on the respective dates to make submissions should clarification of any issue be required. Unless unforeseen circumstances occur, such as in person appearances by respondents, practitioners will be informed at the latest by 09h30 on the day of hearing in which matters Judge Davis will require appearance and oral submissions.
- Virtual hearings shall be heard on MS Teams on each of the motion court days. The hearing link will be shared a day before the court hearing.

**Note**: During a virtual hearing the camera and microphone of only the practitioner making submissions or the party giving evidence shall be on and all other cameras shall be off and microphones shall be muted.

- 4. Practitioners should also check prior to the hearing whether case note have been uploaded on caselines.
- 5. The Consolidated Directives dated 11 May 2020 must be complied with case notes.
