1st & 2nd applicants practice note

- 1st and 2nd applicants were omitted/ousted from completing 3rd year LLB at UWC law faulty by Dean Jaque De Ville on grounds that they were Top Secret James Bond CIA and FBI Agents from the White House in the USA spying on the ANC's intelligentsia at UWC's law faculty.
- 2. 1st and 2nd applicants seek urgent admission from WCHC to complete 4th year LLB on grounds they seeking urgent NSFAS and Attorneys Fidelity Funds to pay their studies [including miscellaneous costs], because they have never received salaries from the White House to be employed as Top Secret James Bond CIA & FBI Agents from the White House in the USA spying on the ANC's intelligentsia at UWC's law faculty.
- 3. Caitlin Halligan from Harvard Law School, Harvard University in Boston, Massachusetts, USA & Faith Gay from from Selendy Gay Elsberg PLLC Attorneys, New York City, New York State, USA – are State Attorneys at the White House in the USA & shall confirm to the WCHC that 1st & 2nd applicants have never received any salaries from the White House to spy on Dean Jaque De Ville or any member of the ANC's intelligentsia at UWC's law faculty.

- 4. Colleen Bailey is the State Attorney in Cape Town, South Africa, to accept and confirm mainstream politics from Caitlin Halligan and Faith Gay that 1st and 2nd applicants have been persecuted, prejudiced and punished because of their father, Tommy Halligan's Irish heritage in Galway Bay, Tuam, Ireland.
- 5. [In due consideration of the abovementioned], Dean Jaque De Ville ordered erstwhile WCHC judge president John Hlophe to give the *Urgent Ex Parte Vexatious Proceedings Act's* interdict against 2nd applicant some 38 court days, later, after 2nd applicant was successful, at the WCHC, [as a trade unions representative], before Louw J, on 10 May 2012 & 20 September 2012, respectively during 2nd applicants' 4 hours remonstrations of arguments in deliberations against Amalgamated Banks of South Africa "ABSA" by clearly saying in his allegations that ABSA's attorneys per Adriaan Van Der Merwe, Clinton Lang from Tim Du Toit Attorneys in Pretoria, South Africa, including, Eloise Nel-Wade from the Cape Bar of Advocates in Cape Town, South Africa, defrauded R500 billion from ABSA's deceased clients estates at the Master of the High Court's Offices in Cape Town, South Africa.

- 10. Prior to the above. It was set down for hearing on the urgent roll, from 18 July 2024 to present time without success because the respondents refusing to attend the court proceedings as stated in the Notice of Motion.
- 11. As per the tenets and peripherals of the Witchcraft Suppression Act No. 3 of 1957, it is herein submitted as correct, that 16 abovesaid respondents must attend the court proceedings and give oral evidence before the WCHC, including Nicole Slabbert, as Portfolio Manager at Ripple Property Management Services, the agents of the Alice Springs Complex of Flats. Also included are the chair of the bar, Janet McCurdie, [14th Floor] and, deputy chair of the bar, Karrisha Pillay, [16th Floor].
- 12. 1st and 2nd applicants seek that their Notice of Motion is giving against the respondents with costs.
