### **1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants practice note**

---

1. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants were omitted/ousted from completing 3<sup>rd</sup> year LLB at UWC law faculty by Dean Jaque De Ville on grounds that they were Top Secret James Bond CIA and FBI Agents from the White House in the USA spying on the ANC's intelligentsia at UWC's law faculty.
2. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants seek urgent admission from WCHC to complete 4<sup>th</sup> year LLB on grounds they seeking urgent NSFAS and Attorneys Fidelity Funds to pay their studies [including miscellaneous costs], because they have never received salaries from the White House to be employed as Top Secret James Bond CIA & FBI Agents from the White House in the USA spying on the ANC's intelligentsia at UWC's law faculty.
3. Caitlin Halligan from Harvard Law School, Harvard University in Boston, Massachusetts, USA & Faith Gay from Selendy Gay Elsberg PLLC Attorneys, New York City, New York State, USA – are State Attorneys at the White House in the USA & shall confirm to the WCHC that 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants have never received any salaries from the White House to spy on Dean Jaque De Ville or any member of the ANC's intelligentsia at UWC's law faculty.

4. Colleen Bailey is the State Attorney in Cape Town, South Africa, to accept and confirm mainstream politics from Caitlin Halligan and Faith Gay that 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants have been persecuted, prejudiced and punished because of their father, Tommy Halligan's Irish heritage in Galway Bay, Tuam, Ireland.
  
5. [In due consideration of the abovementioned], Dean Jaque De Ville ordered erstwhile WCHC judge president John Hlophe to give the *Urgent Ex Parte Vexatious Proceedings Act's* interdict against 2<sup>nd</sup> applicant – some 38 court days, later, after 2<sup>nd</sup> applicant was successful, at the WCHC, [as a trade unions representative], before Louw J, on 10 May 2012 & 20 September 2012, respectively – during 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants' 4 hours remonstrations of arguments in deliberations against Amalgamated Banks of South Africa "ABSA" by clearly saying in his allegations that ABSA's attorneys per Adriaan Van Der Merwe, Clinton Lang from Tim Du Toit Attorneys in Pretoria, South Africa, including, Eloise Nel-Wade from the Cape Bar of Advocates in Cape Town, South Africa, defrauded R500 billion from ABSA's deceased clients estates at the Master of the High Court's Offices in Cape Town, South Africa.
  
6. 2<sup>nd</sup> applicant seeks leave per sections 2(1)(b) & (c) Vexatious Proceedings Act No.53 of 1953:
  
7. The matter is set down for hearing in terms of the Witchcraft Suppression Act No. 3 of 1957 on account of 16 respondents seeking to enslave 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants [to become their slaves] and give them free CCMA, Bargain council, labour court and high court litigation support to earn monies.
  
8. It is to be heard for the 4<sup>th</sup> time on urgent roll Thursday 05 September 2024.

9. Acting judge Adams heard the matter on the urgent roll Thursday 22 August 2024 – without giving judgement [on consideration], that the papers were missing from the court file. It was the 3<sup>rd</sup> time it was set down for hearing.
10. Prior to the above. It was set down for hearing on the urgent roll, from 18 July 2024 to present time without success – because the respondents refusing to attend the court proceedings as stated in the Notice of Motion.
11. As per the tenets and peripherals of the Witchcraft Suppression Act No. 3 of 1957, it is herein submitted as correct, that 16 abovesaid respondents must attend the court proceedings and give oral evidence before the WCHC, including Nicole Slabbert, as Portfolio Manager at Ripple Property Management Services, the agents of the Alice Springs Complex of Flats. Also included are the chair of the bar, Janet McCurdie, [14<sup>th</sup> Floor] and, deputy chair of the bar, Karrisha Pillay, [16<sup>th</sup> Floor].
12. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants seek that their Notice of Motion is giving against the respondents with costs.
13. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants seek UWC senate must immediately expel Dean Jaque De Ville because he summarily caused erstwhile WCHC judge president John Hlophe's expulsion from the judicial Services Commission "JSC".
14. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants seek that the WCHC conduct an inquest into Paul Eia and his family's uncounted murders of thousands of people with Voodoo.
15. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> applicants seek immediate enrolment into UWC's law faculty to complete their LLB.
