RESERVED JUDGMENTS REPORT

1. Introduction

1.1 The Judicial norms and standards for the performance on judicial functions provide, in terms of paragraph 5.2.6, that judgments in both civil and criminal matters, should generally not be reserved without a fixed date for handing down. Judicial Officers have a choice to reserve judgments *sine die* where circumstances are such that the delivery of a judgment on a fixed date is not possible. The norms and standards further determine that save in exceptional cases where it is not possible to do so, every effort shall be made to hand down judgments no later than three (3) months after the last hearing.

1.2 Article 10(2) of the Code of Judicial Conduct adopted in terms of section 12 of the JSC Act, 1994 provides:

“A judge must deliver all reserved judgments before the end of the term in which the hearing of a matter was completed, but may:

- (a) in respect of a matter that was heard within two weeks of the end of that term; or
- (b) where a reserved judgment is of a complex nature or for any other cogent and sound reason and with the consent of the head of the court, deliver that reserved judgment during the course of the next term.”

1.3 At the meeting held on 28 September 2018, the Heads of Court resolved that a reserved judgments report containing a list of judgments outstanding for more than 6 months, will be published on the Judiciary’s website.

2. Reserved Judgments overview during the reporting period

2.1 The 2024, Term 3 sittings of the Constitutional Court, the Supreme Court of Appeal and the Labour Appeals Court commenced on 15 August 2024, whereas the sittings for the High Court, Labour Courts and Land Claims Court commenced from 22 July 2024. Table 1 below provides an overview of the status of reserved judgements as at the beginning of Term 3 of 2024.

2.2 As at the beginning of term 3 of 2024, a total of **1,602** judgments were reported as reserved. A total of **223** of these judgments, representing an overall **14%** of the reserved matters, had been reserved and were outstanding for a period exceeding 6 months. The remaining **1,379** of these judgments, representing an overall **86%**, had been reserved for a period of less than 6 months.

2.3 From table 1 below, it can be seen that nationally, out of a total of **1,602** judgments that were indicated as reserved, the Gauteng Division of the High Court, Pretoria with a total of **246** reserved matters, had the highest number of reserved judgments, followed by the Labour Court, Johannesburg with **201** reserved judgments and Gauteng Local Division, Johannesburg with **151** reserved judgments.

2.4 It is also noted that in terms of the total number of reserved judgments compared to the number of reserved judgments outstanding for six months or longer, the Constitutional Court had the highest proportion of judgments reserved for six months or longer, that is **8** out of **19**, representing **42%** of all matters at the Court, followed by the Northern Cape Division of the High Court, Kimberley with **34%** (**10** out of **29**), the Labour Appeal Court with **33%** (**4** out of **12**) and the North West Division of the High Court, Mahikeng with **24%** (**15** out of **63**).

2.5 Comparing the statistics of the Superior Courts, it is noted that the highest percentage of reserved judgments, outstanding for more than six months, were in the Gauteng Division of the Labour Court, Johannesburg with **19%** (**43** out of **223** matters), followed by the Gauteng Division of the High Court, Pretoria with a percentage of **18%** (**40** out of **223** matters) and North West Division of the High Court, Mahikeng with **14%** (**31** out of **223**).

2.6 A noteworthy observation from the table below is that there were no judgments reserved for more than six months, in the Supreme Court of Appeal; Free State Division of the High Court, Bloemfontein; Limpopo Division of the High Court, Polokwane; Mpumalanga Division of the High Court, Mbombela and Mpumalanga Local Division, Middelburg.

2.7 It is also worth noting that the Competition Appeal Court and Electoral Court did not have any judgment reserved.

2.8 Table 1 below provides a Superior Courts' status overview on the Reserved Judgments outstanding as at the beginning of Court Term 3 of 2024.
