OFFICE OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS OF CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE ELECTORAL COMMISSION

(Constitution Hill, Braamfontein)

The Chief Justice of the Republic of South Africa, in his capacity as the Chairperson of the Panel of representatives, comprising the South African Human Rights Commission, the Commission for Gender Equality and the Public Protector, established in terms of section 6 of the Electoral Commission Act, 1996 (Act No. 51 of 1996), hereby invites nominations to fill a vacancy of a Member of the Electoral Commission (Commission) to serve on a part-time basis.

The Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 read with Electoral Commission Act, 1996 provides that members of the Commission must be men and women who:

- are South African citizens;
- are fit and proper persons to hold that office; and
- not at that stage have a high party-political profile.

Members of the Commission are appointed by the President for a term of seven years. Nominees must indicate their availability to serve on a part time basis.

Nominations motivating the suitability of each candidate accompanied by the candidate's written consent and comprehensive curriculum vitae must be submitted on or before **02 April 2015 to**: The Office of the Chief Justice, Private Bag X1,
